WHAT IS THE CITIZENS POLICE ACADEMY?



The Coral Springs Police Department Citizens Police Academy provides participants with an overview of what actual law enforcement trainees learn during several months of intense training at the academy.

For participants, the Citizens Police Academy is a thorough look at how each topic — from the police budget to traffic enforcement to criminal investigation — relates to and affects our own community. It is not a by-the-book method of conventional law enforcement education.

The Citizens Police Academy is open to any Coral Springs resident or business owner 18 or older. Members of the clergy, City Commissioners and local business owners are among the Academy's graduates.

The Academy is offered once a year and meets one night a week for 13 weeks at the Public Safety Building.
